



First ever 24h endurance race in Romania on this weekend

Announcing the program, rules and participation teams

An historical event for all the electric cars enthusiasts: the first ever 24 hours race in Romanian motorsport will take place in Transilvania Motor Ring and it will be 100% electric. All the electric car owners are invited on the 2nd and 3rd of July 2022 for a Slalom event and/or a 24 hours endurance race in Transilvania Motor Ring.

We are pleased to announce starting this season with the motto: "One weekend - all electric cars". We extended invites to all car manufacturers and auto dealers, so that they will offer electric cars for a test drive for all visitors who would like to test an electric vehicle.



The first 24h endurance race with electric cars in Romania

The first ecoGP race and the first endurance race in Romanian motorsport will take place in Transilvania Motor Ring on this electric weekend. 8 electric car owners created teams with 3 and more members to the 24H competition. All teams are invited to a Slalom race that will take part on July 2, before the endurance race. All the teams will be positioned at the start line of the 24H race according to the result obtained at the Slalom.

Drivers will come with a pure electric car and a lot of energy and patience to conquer the race. We have already 9 teams that registered for the 24H challenge and they will compete and beat the Eco Grand Prix record.

"We at ecoGP are showing that this is a thrilling competitive race series which also encourages people to think about buying EVs. Also, we want to show that EVs can stand up to the toughest tests in harsh conditions" said Rafael de Mestre – the initiator of the Eco Grand Prix series.



Test Drive Electric Weekend

All participants and visitors are invited to test drive all the electric cars available at the circuit. There will be the latest electric car brands: Skoda Enyaq, Volkswagen ID5, Volkswagen E-up, Audi TRON-E. The registration for the test drive will be open at the ecoGP office.

Also, you will be able to enjoy the food court available and the atmosphere filled with adrenaline and joy.

In addition, all ecoGP visitors and participants can conduct unforgettable sightseeing to Dracula's Castle, which is located nearby in the city of Bran. Explore the untouched nature of the mountains in cities like Brasov or Targu Mures!



Event program

The official entry for participants and exhibitors will be held on July 1, starting by 7PM. We will organize a team briefing to inform all participants about the rules and regulations of the races. The ecoGP initiator Rafael de Mestre will train the participants and they will be able to ask everything that is needed and every participating team member will agree with the presented rules. Teams will be registered at 9PM and they will receive all the materials they need for the race (car number, program of the race, helmets).

The Slalom race will start on July 2 and every electric car owner will be able to participate. All registered teams will pass the technical inspection that will be done by Eco Grand Prix Pit Bulls, the members of the organization team paying attention to compliance with the rules. If needed the owner of the electric car will give access to a Pit Bull to mount lights, cameras and any other technical equipment needed to perform the competition to the car and test the charging. Special thanks to our sponsors SIMFONY, who is delivering the SIM cards for our IOT GPS tracker solution and EVOxxx company which is supporting us with the mobile charger.

Access

To reach the Transilvania Motor Ring it is highly recommended not to trust the navigation system. Use the coordinates 46.428542, 24.442752 to reach the entry and follow the road.

Season 2022 is planned to have 6 races

This year, the Eco Grand Prix 2022 [calendar](#) will consist of six main races and the participation will be counted in the overall annual rating. Soon we will add more details to the race calendar about two additional race tracks: Czech Ring and another race track in Germany with competition dates October/November 2022.

The first ecoGP series took place in Spain in 2013 and it was initiated by Rafael de Mestre, the series' founder. Originally from Spain, but established in Romania, Rafael has traveled twice around the world with his own electric car and has been promoting the message that electric cars have a good range and they are able to charge everywhere: "Wherever there is a light burning then you can charge your car!" – Rafael de Mestre.
